1. Articles in English (MS word font- Times New Roman, Font size-12) or Bengali (Avro, Font size-12). The manuscripts can only be written in English or Bengali.

i) Title- Should be brief and informative.

ii) Authors Name- Name must be followed by Designation, Postal Address including E-mail ID and Phone Number.

iii) For compilation of bibliography, the latest edition of APA and MLA format is to be used.

iv) The paper should contain maximum 2500 words including references and abstract.

v) Editors reserve the right to make correction or changes, if it deemed necessary for publication.

vi) The Publication of the Articles/Write-up will be only after the recommendation of the Editorial Board

2. Plagiarism: The Authors are requested to avoid plagiarism. In case of detection of plagiarism Authors himself/herself will be solely responsible.

3. There shall be **No Publication fees** for papers.
